



# Notice of traffic management in Gawcott

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

We are continually reviewing the works on our construction sites in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with COVID-19. The Government's current strategy makes it clear that construction activity can continue as long as it complies with this guidance. Please be assured that only sites that can operate within the guidelines are operational. All sites will remain under constant review. We have postponed all face-to-face engagement events and meetings and have put in place a number of channels to communicate with communities, such as letters and phone calls, as well as updates and alerts from each of the local community websites. ## What are we doing?

Traffic management is being put along Radclive Road in order to control the increase in traffic resulting from nearby HS2 works. The work will comprise of temporary traffic lights and a section of Radclive Road being restricted to a single lane. The traffic management is due to be put in place during March 2021 and last for a period of around three years whilst the HS2 main construction works takes place.

## Why are these works required?

Traffic management is required as Radclive road is part of a designated HGV traffic route for vehicles travelling to and from the HS2 construction activity in the Calvert area. HGV's will travel from the A421 along Radclive Road into Gawcott and then turn left along Hillesden road to travel to construction sites in the Calvert area and return using the same route. HGV numbers will be closely monitored to make sure they remain within the allowed limit, the route along the A421 is from the West, and HGV's are not permitted to travel through Buckingham. Works will start in March 2021 and continue for around three years.

The temporary traffic lights will be in operation when HGV traffic use the route through Gawcott.

Typically, this will be Monday to Friday and Saturday mornings. It will also be occasionally required outside these times.

Normal temporary traffic light operating times will be:

Monday to Friday

7am – 7pm

Saturdays

7am – 2pm

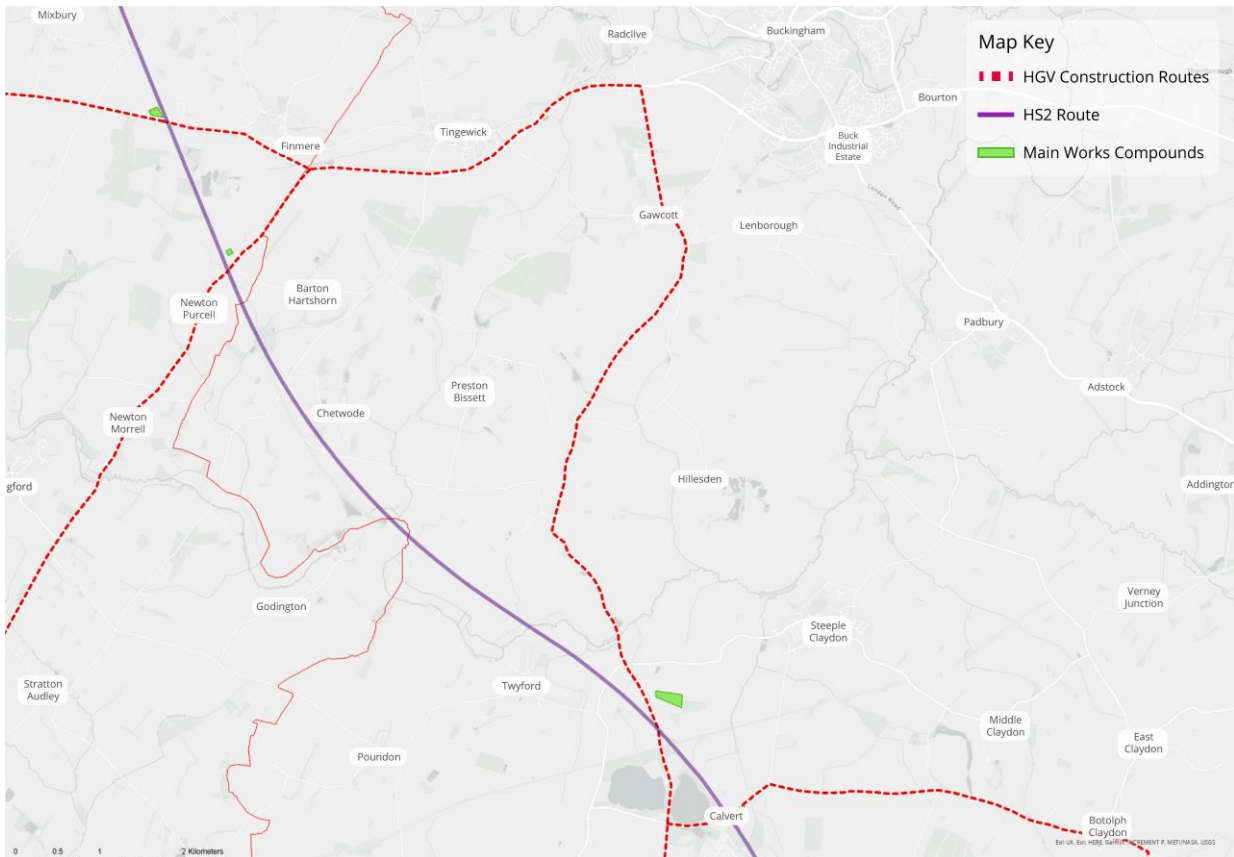
